PMH Atwater, LHD **EDGES: Near-Death Experiences As You've Never Seen Them Before: The Life, Deaths, and Research of P.M.H. Atwater**

The journey each human being faces is not an easy one, and Sandra Champlain does not think it is meant to be. In 1977, I died three times in three months, each time I had a near-death experience, and each was different. In my third, a voice larger than big told me—and I quote: "Test revelation. You are to do the research. One book for each death." Book one was not named; I suspect it was my first one: *Coming Back to Life*. Book two: *Future*

Memory. Book three: *A Manual for Developing Humans*. Being a cop's kid raised in a police station, I used police investigative techniques as my protocol. Elisabeth Kubler-Ross, whom I met at O'Hare Airport near Chicago, listened to my story and said I was a near-death survivor. She never mentioned Raymond Moody, nor had I heard of him or his famous book. In my first episode of "living the future before it occurred," I saw myself quitting my bank job and moving to Falls Church, Virginia. This I did, and there I began my work interviewing others like myself, work that has continued unabated for 44 years.

PMH Atwater, LHD, had three near-death experiences in three months in 1977, which turned her life around completely. The following year she turned to research because of what she was told to do during her third episode—and she became one of the pioneers in the field of near-death studies, completing 18 books on or related to the subject. Some of her findings have been verified in clinical settings, among them the prospective study done in Holland and published in the Lancet. To date, her work covers nearly 5,000 adult and child experiencers. Her website is pmhatwater.com

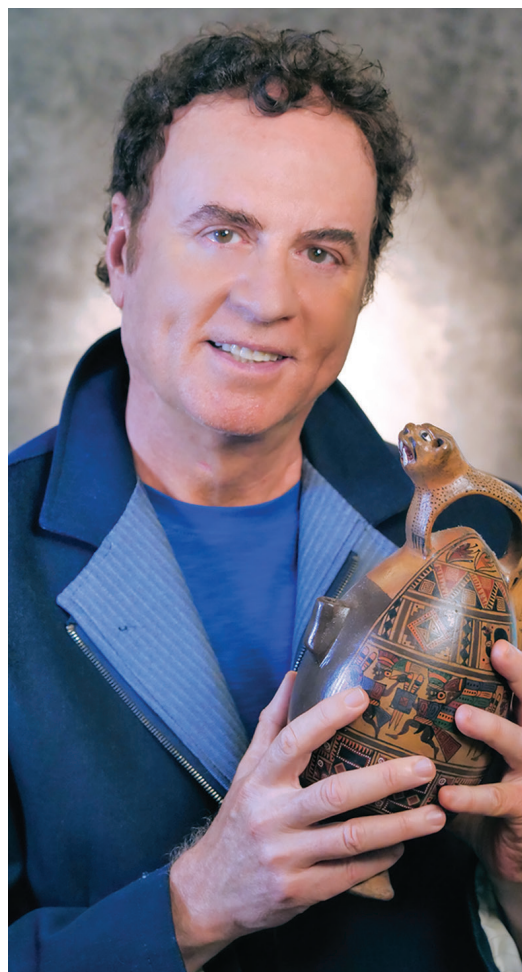

Jeffrey Long, MD (prerecorded) **with LIVE Q&A with Jody Long, JD** **Oneness, Love, and God: Groundbreaking New Insights From a Survey** **of 834 Near-Death Experiencers (HERS)**

Thursday 4:30 - 5:30 pm

A survey of 834 near-death experiencers (NDErs) included questions about awareness during their NDEs regarding: (a) any specific information / awareness that a mystical universal connection or unity/oneness exists, (b) any specific information / awareness regarding love, and (c) any specific information / awareness that God or a supreme being exists. A remarkably high percentage of NDErs answered 'Yes' to these questions: 47.1%, 57.1%,

and 48.0%, respectively. All three of these questions allowed a narrative response. These narrative responses showed remarkably consistent insights: (a) NDErs often found that a mystical universal connection/unity/oneness really exists, (b) NDErs often described the unearthly love in their NDEs as a part of everything, as if love connects everyone and everything, and (c) NDErs often reported that God is beyond earthly words to describe and is a reality.

Jeffrey Long, MD, is a radiation oncology physician living in Houma, Louisiana. Over 20 years ago, he founded the Near-Death Experience Research Foundation (nderf.org). Dr. Long has investigated over 3,500 near-death experiences (NDEs), which is by far the largest number of NDEs ever scientifically studied. Portions of the NDERF website have been posted in over 30 languages, allowing global outreach. The results of his previous research were published in the New York Times bestselling book Evidence of the Afterlife: The Science of Near-Death Experiences. Millions of people have seen Dr. Long discuss his research on shows including the NBC Today Show, The Dr. Oz Show, National Geographic television, the History Channel, The O'Reilly Factor, and on television broadcasts around the world.

NDE Evidence and the Next Steps in Mind-Brain Research (HERS)

Thursday 4:30 - 5:30 pm

NDEs provide strong evidence that the nonmaterial mind is a separate entity that interfaces with the brain in ordinary consciousness—a view that requires a radical shift in neuroscience. Earlier scientific revolutions like the heliocentric view of

the heavens took more than a century to be accepted, whereas more recent revolutions like the structure of the atom took less than 20 years. The difference was the ability to provide convincing evidence and a model of the new paradigm to other scientists. We present the NDE evidence for the separate mind entity and a model of, and evidence for, mind-brain interaction. There is good NDE evidence that the nonmaterial mind interacts with physical matter, including neural mechanisms, and there is good neurological evidence from neural structures and anesthesiology that suggests an interface for the mind to work with the brain. What is needed now is a research program to validate this model of mind-brain interaction.

Robert and Suzanne Mays have studied NDE phenomena together for over 40 years, although neither has had an NDE. They are particularly interested in veridical perceptions during NDEs and apparent interactions during NDEs between the NDEr and physical reality, as well as the neurological evidence of the interaction of the nonmaterial mind with the brain during ordinary consciousness, especially in language comprehension and in memory formation and recall. Their current areas of focus are on (a) NDErs' prophetic visions of world events, (b) describing the nature of the transcendent realm as is evident in NDEr accounts, and (c) understanding the nature of consciousness as an individuated mind-entity directly interacting with a physical body and brain, as opposed to a non-localized entity spread out across all of existence, transmitting to and receiving from the physical brain.

NDEs in Salt Lake City: The Luminous Mormon View of Near-Death Phenomena

Without discussing the rightness or wrongness of Mormonism, Dr. O'Driscoll explains in this presentation why many Mormons comfortably embrace near-death experiences. Although much of the Western Judeo-Christian world looks askance at NDEs and related phenomena, most Mormons, or members of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, as they prefer to be called, view glimpses of eternity and end-of-life phenomena as normal, scriptural, and edifying. Indeed, though Mormons use a different nomenclature than the NDE community does, they accept the eternal and divine nature of the human soul, communications with Deity, and after-death communications as a basis for belief at a personal level and as the source of Mormon doctrine at an institutional level. Although such experiences are considered sacred, sharing them is acceptable and sometimes encouraged. When spiritual and faith traditions understand one another's lexicon, they may realize they are much nearer a timeless oneness than they ever imagined.

After decades of silence, award-winning author and international speaker, Dr. Jeff O'Driscoll, finally share spiritual experiences from his 25 years in the emergency department. He saw souls leave their bodies at death, communicated with them, and sometimes received impressions about how to care for his patients. His experiences began in childhood after his brother died in a farm accident. After stepping away from clinical medicine, he published his compelling memoir, Not Yet, and works to help others understand their spiritual experiences.

William Peters, MA, MEd, MFT, is the founder of the Shared Crossing Project whose mission is to positively transform relationships to death and dying through education and raising awareness about extraordinary end-of-life experiences (shared crossings) and their healing benefits. As the director of the Shared Crossing Research Initiative, William and his team collect and study shared crossings. William is a global leader in shared death studies and end-of-life phenomena. He teaches methods to facilitate the shared death experience and to assist experiencers in meaningfully integrating their experiences. William is a psychotherapist and served as a hospice worker with Zen Hospice Project in San Francisco. His work is informed by his two NDEs and a variety of shared crossings. William's work has appeared in the American Journal of Hospice and Palliative Medicine and in Omega – Journal of Death and Dying. William's book, At Heaven's Door: What Shared Journeys to the Afterlife Teach About Dying Well and Living Better, is published by Simon & Schuster.

Michael Kinsella, PhD, is Chief of Research for the Shared Crossing Research Initiative (SCRI), a non-profit entity devoted to studying end-of-life experiences and their therapeutic benefits. Together with the SCRI team, Dr. Kinsella recently published articles on shared end-of-life experiences that have appeared in the American Journal of Hospice and Palliative Medicine (2021) and Omega - Journal of Death and Dying (2022). Michael also served as a contributing author to William Peters' recent book At Heaven's Door: What Shared Journeys to the Afterlife Teach About Dying Well and Living Better (2022). In addition to writing and research, Michael teaches university courses on death and dying and works as a hospice volunteer.

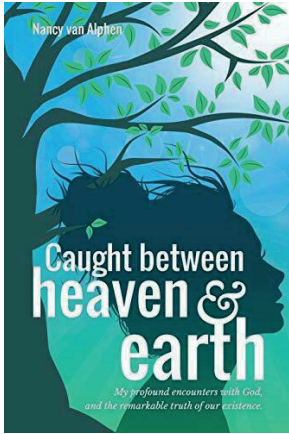
The History and Impact of Near-Death Experiences on The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints from 1784 to the Present

Saturday 9:00 - 10:00 am

The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints ("Mormon" Church) was founded in 1830 by 24-year-old Joseph Smith, based on a vision that had many NDE elements. Later, he was visited by an angel who, after delivering a message, departed through a tunnel into heaven. On one occasion, a mob beat Smith and left him for dead. During the attack, Smith experienced his spirit leave his body, and he watched the rest of the assault from above. From 1784 to the present, thousands of Latter-day Saints have had extensive NDEs, including Mormon

leader Jedediah Grant. In 1920, a Mormon leader from Idaho, Heber Hale, shared his NDE in the Church's conference. Details of these and other NDEs in Mormon Faith, in Judaism, in early Christianity, and in other faiths will be described. The presenter will conclude with the suggestion that traditional religions should not be skeptical of NDEs—and neither should those who accept NDEs be skeptical of tradition religion. Both share common roots.

For over 30 years, Martin Tanner has been the host of the Religion Today show on KSL Radio, a 50,000-watt, clear channel, AM/FM and Internet simulcast station. He was among the early interviewers of Bruce Greyson, MD; Raymond Moody, MD, PhD; George Ritchie, MD; Rev. Howard Storm; Melvin Morse, MD; Betty Eadie; and many others. Tanner's show is picked up by Apple Podcasts, Google Podcasts, Spotify, and many others. For over a decade Tanner's Religion Today show has been listed as one of the top 20 religious podcasts, discussing such topics as science, religion, atheism, archaeology, and politics. Martin Tanner was a co-founder of the Utah IANDS local group in 1990, one of the largest IANDS affiliates, and he serves currently as vice president of IANDS. He is a business consultant and meditator.

In 2020, aerospace entrepreneur Robert T. Bigelow founded the Bigelow Institute for Consciousness Studies (BICS). BICS's mission includes "to communicate, facilitate, educate and organize scientific research and exploration into the survival of human

consciousness (SOHC)" with a particular focus on consciousness surviving permanent bodily death. Following a successful competition in 2021 for essays providing the best evidence for SOHC, BICS is now looking to the future. In this presentation, Robert Bigelow and Colm Kelleher will reveal the details, including application process and important dates, for BICS's new grants program for 2023, called "The Challenge", that promises to significantly impact the future of research in the field of SOHC. <https://www.bigelowinstitute.org/>

Robert T. Bigelow, a Las Vegas entrepreneur, is the Founder and President of the Bigelow Institute for Consciousness Studies. BICS was founded in 2020 to support research into both the survival of human consciousness after physical death and, based on data from such studies, the nature of the afterlife. In 2021, BICS launched a highly publicized and very successful global essay competition in which \$1,800,000 was awarded to 29 winning essays. The essay requirement was to provide the best evidence beyond a reasonable doubt that human consciousness survives bodily death.

Mr. Bigelow graduated from Arizona State University with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration. He is an experienced general contractor, designer, developer, financier, buyer, and manager of many large real estate projects in the US. Over the course of his career spanning many decades, he has designed and built numerous apartment complexes, including the Budget Suites of America hotel chain that is currently in three southwestern states.

In 1999, Robert Bigelow founded Bigelow Aerospace, LLC, to provide general contracting and research and development for the design, development, and construction of habitable space structures for private enterprise and government use. Mr. Bigelow personally provided all financial support totaling over \$350 million dollars. He has successfully launched two subscale spacecraft called Genesis I & II into orbit as well as the Bigelow Expandable Activity Module (BEAM), which is attached to the Tranquility module of the International Space Station. Moreover, Mr. Bigelow served as the program manager of the B330 spacecraft – Bigelow Aerospace's main habitation system for Low Earth Orbit (LEO) and beyond LEO destinations. He also holds 29 patents on aerospace systems and hardware.

Colm Kelleher, PhD, obtained his doctorate in biochemistry from the University of Dublin Trinity College. He has spent 35 years of his working life in a wide variety of diverse careers. Between 1991-1996, he was an immunology research scientist at the National Jewish Center in Denver Colorado. Between 1996-2004, Kelleher led the National Institute for Discovery Science (NIDS) team on Skinwalker Ranch and multiple other NIDS projects. From 2004-2008, Colm served as laboratory director at San Francisco biotechnology company Prosetta where he led teams of scientists in executing U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) contracts to discover drugs against the Ebola virus, Rift Valley Fever Virus, Junin, Machupo, Marburg, and other viruses of interest to DoD. In 2008, Kelleher became deputy administrator of Bigelow Aerospace Advanced Space Studies (BAASS) where he led the day-to-day operations in executing the AAWSAP contract with the U.S. Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA). From 2012-2020, Kelleher led the Environmental Control and Life Support Systems (ECLSS) Department at Bigelow Aerospace, where he managed 11 separate projects that cumulatively resulted in the building of life support systems for expandable spacecraft in Low Earth Orbit (LEO). Kelleher is the author of Brain Trust, published by Simon & Schuster, and in 2005 he co-authored Hunt for the Skinwalker with award winning journalist George Knapp.

NDERF is a science research organization where over 5,000 experiences are posted on our website. But when we I talk about NDEs, I'm looking for the best evidence to understand the concepts that I am interested in researching. I will explain a little bit of the science involved in analyzing experiences. This goes to the reliability and consistency of the results of the study. Other researchers will be easily able to verify the data and repeat the results. Frequently, NDERs report that "love is all there is," but what does that mean? First, we need to define our terms: What is love? Are we talking about love on Earth, or is there something more to it? After reading so many NDEs, I think that the description of "love times a million" would mean that we can only perceive a small portion of what love on Earth means. That means a better way to frame the issue would be looking at love as NDERs perceive it, because they've experienced love without body/mind filters. What commonalities do we see on the other side? Can all of this be related to "love," or are these separate parts of the experience? The answers may surprise you as science may, indeed, hold the keys to making sense of this world and the next.

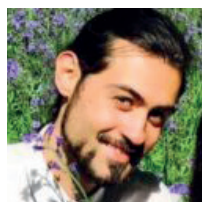

Going Beyond Near-Death Experiences: How I Changed My Earthly Life After Returning

A Marriage of Heaven and Hell: How Oneness in Psychedelic and Near-Death Experiences May Be Both Bound By and Beyond The Brain

Mystical Experience (ME) encompasses, as a defining dimension, 'Oneness.' This profound experience is not only emergent in NDEs but is also reliably precipitated via serotonergic psychedelics. The neural correlates of the psychedelic ME will be clearly delineated, with the implication that these may also underlie MEs of NDEs. Additionally, although 'bliss' is usually another ME dimension, its absence is also reported, such as in challenging NDEs and psychedelic experiences. As such, a case of a spiritual emergency after psilocybin will be shared in which the predictive processing theory of the brain informed its remission. However, despite recourse to neural mechanisms here, unexplained anomalous phenomena, such as psi, are very common in both NDE and psychedelic experiences. Indeed, a hypothesis of psi will be offered entailing the entropic brain theory, which gestures toward post-materialism but also calls for a reconciliation with neuroscience: a marriage of 'Heaven and Hell.'

Children and the Light: Lessons From a Lifetime of Living an NDE

In those films, this deeper reality was visited by swallowing a red pill—much like Plato's metaphor, some four centuries before Christ, of the enlightened who break their chains and exit the cave of shadows to enter the sunlight of truth. Our conviction at NDE Radio—that NDEs provide that “red pill” visit to the deeper reality—is that we are helping demonstrate to listeners around the world the oneness we share with each another and with the Earth itself. Is there a lasting impact when listen to what NDErs are telling us? 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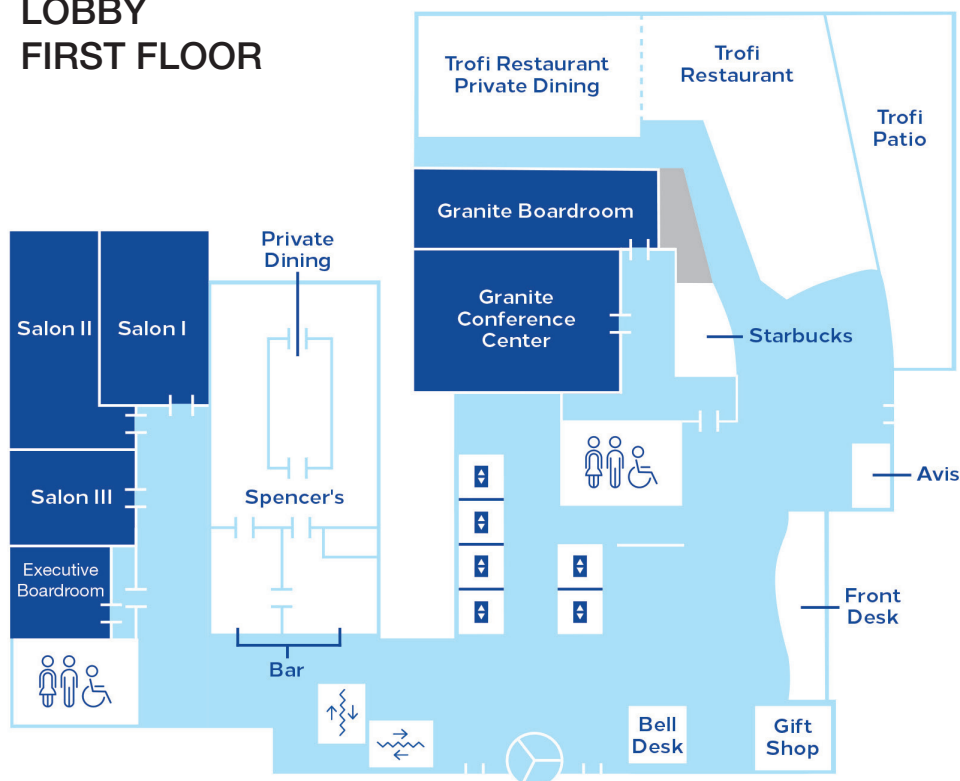
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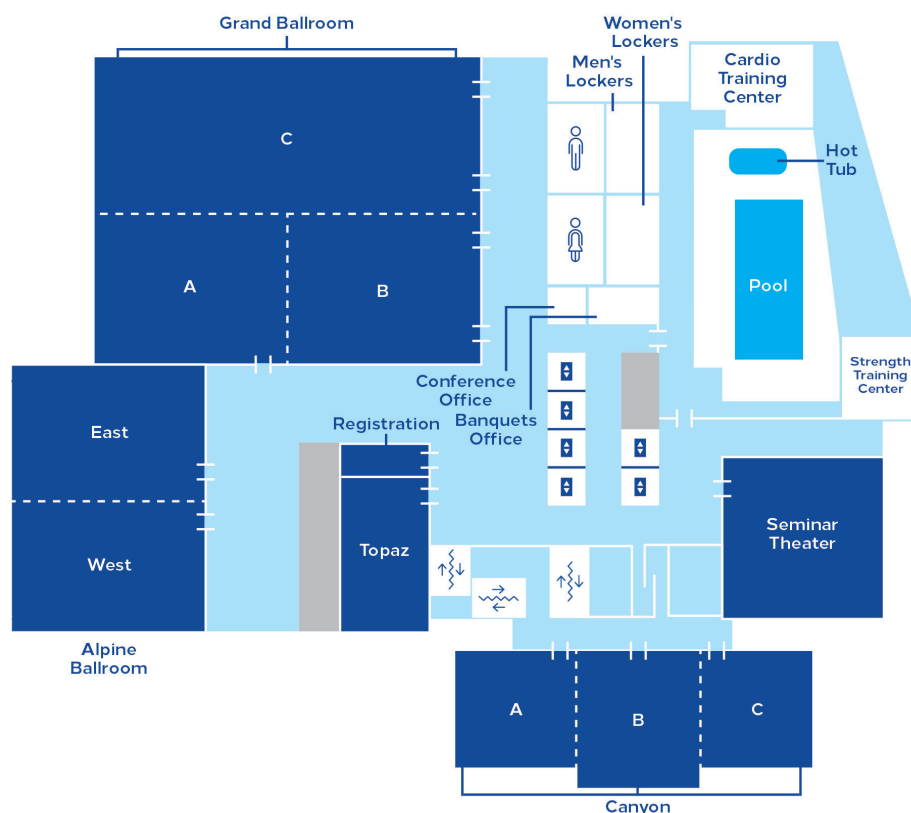
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
